**Lost and Found** items are in the office. If your child is missing a jacket please check with us.

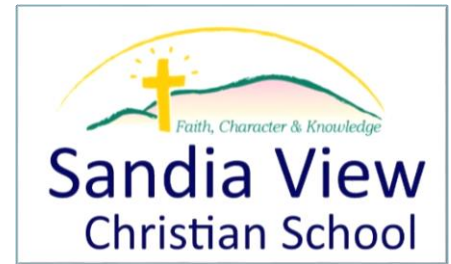
