Congratulations to our Boys Basketball team on their 3rd place win!



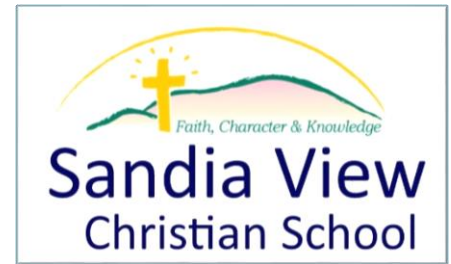
